Wednesday 5 September 2012, Melbourne Ten Australians have won the opportunity to present their innovations to the world's elite business thinkers and leaders this year at Creative Innovation Asia Pacific 2012 as recipients of the Ci2012 Innovation Leader Scholarship.

From a pool of over 100 applications ten emerging leaders were selected for their achievements in fulfilling a vision and leading innovation to a broader community or group. The ten scholarship winners each receive a place at this year's Creative Innovation 2012 giving them the opportunity to rub shoulders with key industry leaders, share and discuss their ideas and issues and a present their innovation ideas to renowned event speakers and event attendees.

Sally is the Founder and Editor of Sustahood; a resource and community for anyone interested in sustainability. She is also building the Youth Food Movement, a group who are transforming Australia's food system into a fair and sustainable one.

Rowan Lamont (Brisbane, QLD) Design thinker, industrial designer and Founding Director of Transformative Technology Research Group; using 3D printing to change global manufacturing practices. Rowan is a founding member of "Root Juice", an alternative to sugar-based drinks for young men.

Dr Shelley Meagher (Brighton, VIC) Writer, literary artist, entrepreneur, strategist and teacher, Shelley is Co-Founder of Do it on the Roof, a campaign which aims to persuade building owners to create public, natural green roofs and illustrates the commercial and community benefits of this strategy.

Avis Mulhall (Bondi, NSW) Cocial entrepreneur and Founder of Think Act Change, Loo Loo Paper and Co-Founder of mmMule.com using online platforms globally to create a powerful group of change-makers. Loo Loo Paper sells toilet paper by subscription and donates 100% of profits to NGOs working to eradicate diarrhoeal diseases in developing countries.

Darryl Nichols (Bondi, NSW) Cofounder of the Garage Sale Trail, a national community-based marketplace that's about sustainability, community, commerce & fun! He's a creative thinker & passionate believer in the power of collaboration.

Julian O'Shea (North Melbourne, VIC) Founding Director of Engineers Without Borders Institute. Julian is an award-winning humanitarian engineer who is passionate about applying appropriate technology to improve the quality of life in the world's most disadvantaged communities.
