Inventor's big chance

Subiaco inventor Mustafa Atee has been given the 60-second chance of a lifetime to pitch his invention, ePAT, to global business thinkers and leaders at Creative Innovation Asia Pacific 2016.

He invented ePAT, the world's first mobile medical application that uses facial recognition to assess pain in people unable to communicate, such as those with Alzheimer's disease.

Mr Atee was one of nine emerging leaders selected for their achievements as founders of start-up commercial or social enterprises.

As part of his award, he was selected to appear at this year's Creative Innovation conference from November 7 to 9 in Melbourne.
